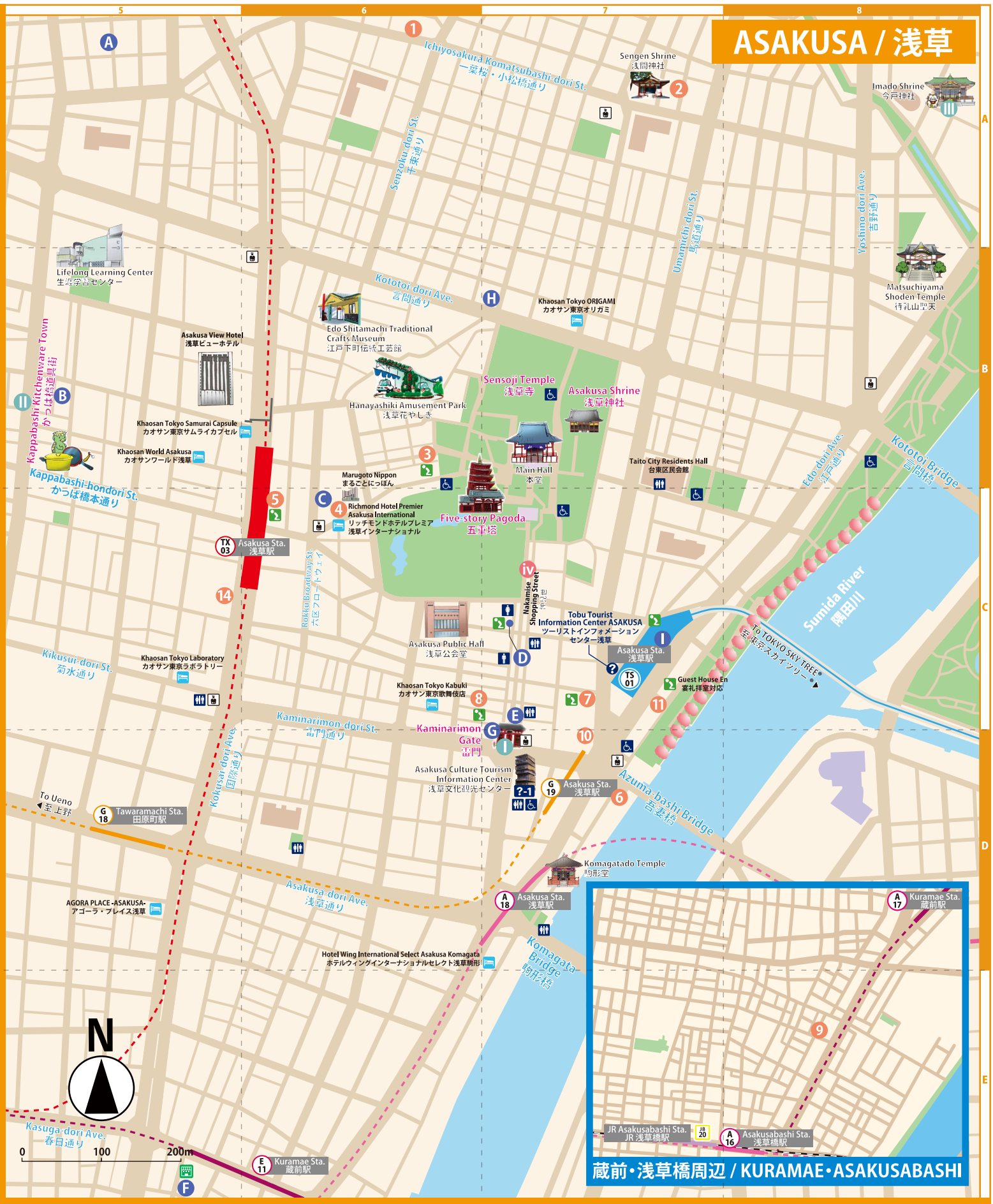
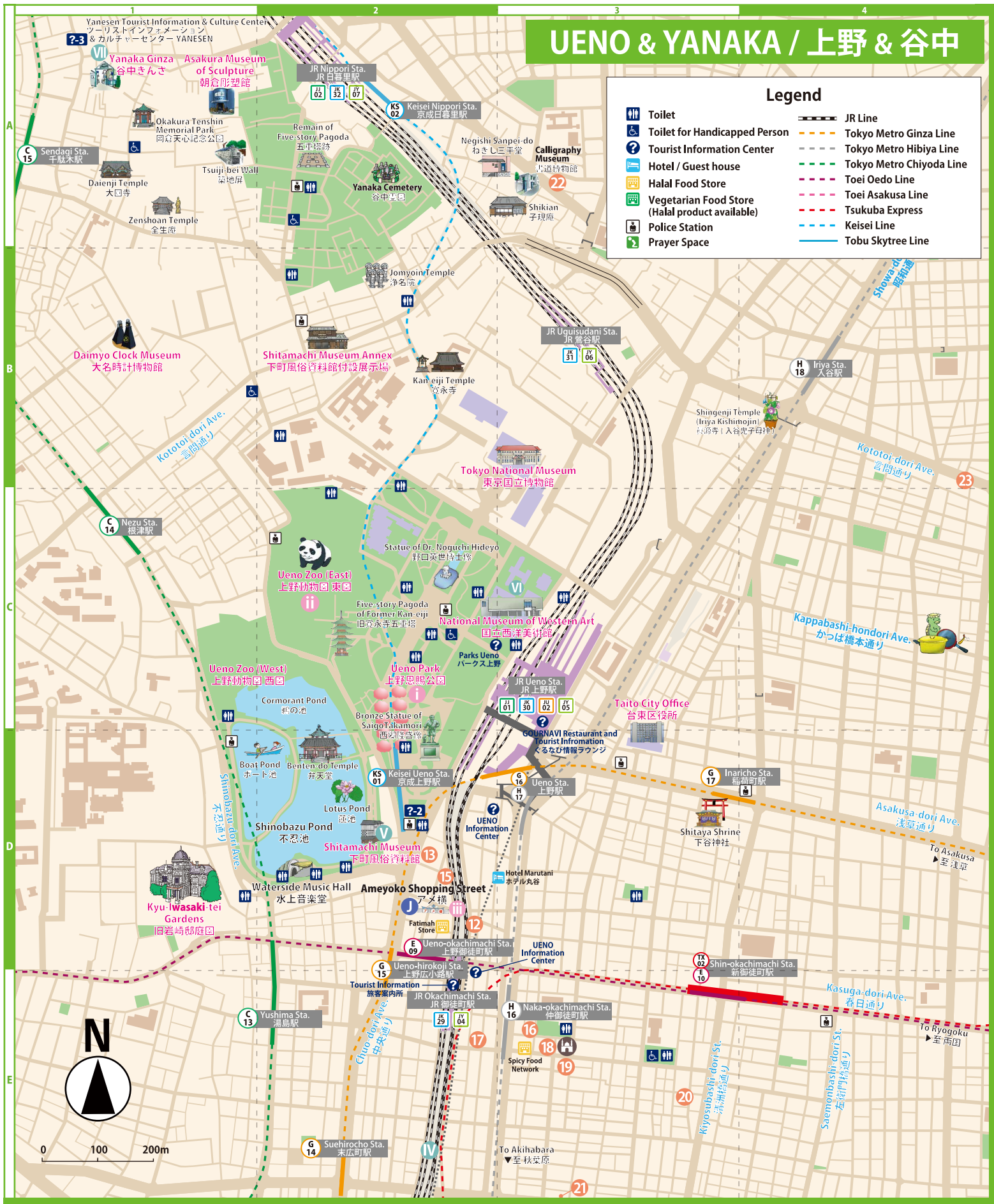




Asakusa, Ueno, & Yanaka Movie
